Springfield-Nashville commuter bus service begins Tuesday

A new Springfield-Nashville commuter bus service begins Tuesday with the launch of the Regional Transportation Authority's Relax and Ride bus service.

Buses will tentatively leave Springfield each workday at 5:43 a.m. and 6:23 a.m., arriving in Nashville at 6:36 a.m. and 7:20 a.m., respectively. A full schedule will be posted on the Robertson County Chamber of Commerce website.

Robertson County Mayor Howard Bradley said he's pleased the new service is coming to Springfield.

"This is one of the best things that could have happened," he said. "It will add a new link to Nashville."
